Do Not Lie

Have you ever thought that the very first sin recorded in the Bible was the telling of a lie? In Genesis chapters 1 and 2, we read that God created the world in six days. On the sixth day, God created man. In Genesis 2, we read of God placing man in the Garden of Eden. Within that garden was the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. In Genesis 2:16-17, we read where God told the man, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die." Jan Day - surgical biopsy of breast Then we read that God made a woman to be a "helper comparable" to the man (Gen. 2:18-25). The man's name was Adam, and the woman's name was Eve.

> But in chapter 3 of Genesis, we read about the big lie that is told. Here we read where the serpent, otherwise known as the Devil and Satan (Rev. 12:9), questions Eve, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?" Eve replied, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die." The serpent then tells the big lie, "You will not surely die. For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." We then read where Eve and her husband Adam ate from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. We then read about humankind's fall into sin due to someone believing a lie. The Apostle Paul later observed, "Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned" (Rom. 5:12).

> Have you ever thought about how destructive a lie is? When someone lies, they are stating that which is not real. When someone states that which is not real, trust is undermined. When trust is undermined, doubt and confusion ensue. How many relationships have been destroyed because of a lie? How many societies have collapsed because of lies? For people to function optimally, they must be able to operate within reality. Questions such as "What does this cost?" to "What must I do to be saved?" must be answered truthfully and honestly. People must be honest with each other, and people must be honest with themselves. In John 8:32, Jesus stated that the "truth shall make you free." If truth can be freeing, then is it equally true that a lie can be enslaving? Truth is freeing because it allows a person to operate within reality, whereas lies are enslaving because they deny reality and hinder further growth.

> We also must never forget that lying carries severe, eternal consequences. In Revelation 21:8, the Apostle John records that God said, "But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death." Let us always strive to be truthful. As the Apostle Paul wrote, "Therefore, putting away lying, 'Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor,' for we are members of one another" (Eph. 4:25).


