Be Kind to One Another

In 1998, singer and songwriter Jewel Kilcher released her song "Hands." One of the lyrics in this song is, "In the end, only kindness matters." An anonymous author wrote, "The ministry of kindness is a ministry which may be achieved by all men, rich and poor, learned and illiterate. Brilliance of mind and capacity for deep thinking have rendered great service to humanity, but by themselves, they are impotent to dry a tear or mend a broken heart."

Christians are called on to be kind to everyone out of consideration of how kind God has been to us. We are to be abundant in offering forgiveness, for God has abundantly forgiven us. How much better the church and the world would be if everyone were kind!

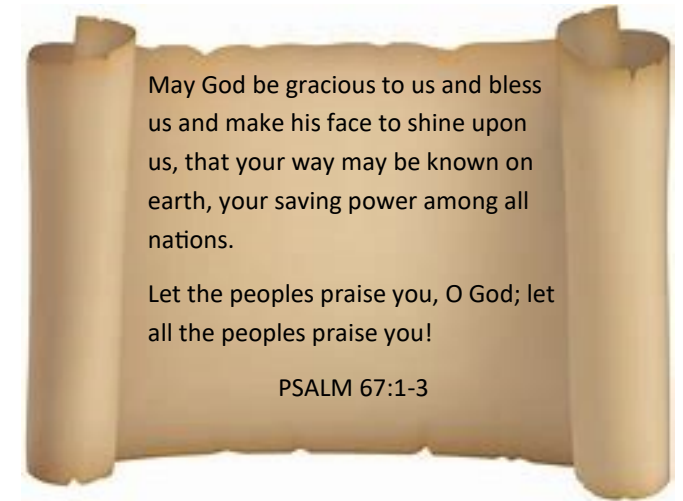
